

TOWNSHIP OF ADMASTON/BROMLEY

Public Planning Meeting

Council held a public planning meeting at the Municipal Council Chambers on Thursday, November 19th, 2015 at 7:15 p.m. Council members present were Mayor Michael Donohue, Deputy Mayor Robert Dick, Councillors Bob Hall, Kevin LeGris and Mike Quilty. Staff members present were Clerk-Treasurer Annette Louis and Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Michelle Oatman. Members of the press present were Peter Dewolf MY FM and Peter Clark Renfrew Mercury. Members of the public present were David Kelly.

Mayor Donohue called the public planning meeting to order.

Mayor Donohue reported that the public planning meeting was being held to consider a Zoning By-Law Amendment requested by David Kelly.

Consent applications B166/14(1), B167/14(2), B168/14(3), B1/15, B6/15(1), and B7/15(2) were submitted to the County of Renfrew for the conveyance of severed lands to be added to adjacent properties on part of Lot 17 and 18 Concession 8, in the Geographic Township of Admaston. The severed lands are required to be rezoned to match the zoning of the lots being added to and to recognize that access is by a private road.

The purpose of the amendment is to rezone the severed lands in severance applications B166/14(1), B167/14(2), B168/14(3), B1/15, B6/15(1), and B7/15(2) so that following the lot additions, the enlarged parcels consist of only one zone.

The effect of the amendment is to rezone the severed lands from Rural (RU) to Limited Service Residential (LSR).

The clerk reported that notice of the public meeting was mailed to twenty-four property owners of land within 120 metres of the land affected by the zoning amendment on October 21st, 2015.

Notice was also sent to the:

- Owners
- To six public bodies as required
- County of Renfrew C.A.O./Clerk.

No written comments were received.

Seeing no other comments or inquiries, Mayor Donohue called a brief recess of 5 minutes at 7:20 p.m.

Mayor Donohue called the meeting back into session at 7:25 p.m. and provided an explanation on the appeal process.

Hearing no concerns or objections the Thursday November 19th Public Planning meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
