



Township of Admaston/Bromley Notice of Changes to Recycling Program

Please Note that after a long relationship with the Township, on June 23rd Beauman's Waste Management Systems abruptly and unexpectedly gave notice of the cessation of their collection and processing of recyclables. Staff immediately implemented stop gap measures pending further investigation. Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery Centre has the capacity to process the Townships recycling and as the most environmentally responsible course of action, they will ensure that the materials diverted from the landfill are recycled. To avoid higher processing fees and to assist our residents in effectively diverting recyclable materials to Ottawa Valley Waste Recovery Centre three recycling assistants have been hired to sort and remove contaminated items from the recycling stream and to reinforce messaging to residents regarding acceptable materials and proper sorting.

Please be advised that mixing contaminated material and garbage with clean recyclable material will cost the Township higher processing fees and ultimately the material will end up in the landfill.
